ue to the high **pollution** (污染) level in the world, there has been an increase (增加) in the number of asthma (哮 喘) patients. When you **breathe** (呼吸), the air goes through tubes called airways (氣道).

Airways have muscles around them. Inside the airways, there is a thin layer. When you have asthma, the layer gets red and makes a lot of mucus (黏液). The muscles around the airways get tighter. These all make it harder to breathe.

This is why asthma patients (患者) have symptoms (症狀) like coughing (咳嗽), shortness of breath and tightness in the chest. Around 6.2 percent of Hong Kong's **population** (人口) have asthma.

## You can save our air!

- Recycle paper, plastic, glass bottles and aluminium cans.
- Reuse materials like paper bags and boxes.
- Use public transportation.
- Don't use air conditioning when it's unnecessary.
- Choose recycled products.
