

Germany

GERMANY, located in north-central Europe, is **bordered** (接界) on the north by the Baltic Seas.

From 1949 to 1990, the country was divided into West and East Germany, but it was **unified** (統一) in 1990, with Berlin as its **capital** (首都).

There are major rivers such as the Danube, Rhine, Elbe and Main. German is the national **language** (語言), but English is also widely spoken.

Germany has excellent **transport** (運輸) infrastructure. It has reliable public transport with very fast trains and a large **internal** (內部的) **network** (網絡) of motorways. There are also regular inbound flights between the major cities.

The **currency** (貨幣) of Germany is the EURO.

World Cup begins in Germany on Friday. Watch out for the first two matches which will take place on 9 June!
