N 27 May, an **earthquake** (地震) killed more than 6,000 people and **injured** (受傷) thousands more on the Indonesian island of Java. Indonesia (印尼), the world's largest **archipelago** (群島), suffers from earthquakes due to its location on the Pacific "Ring of Fire," an arc of Yogyakarta **encircling** (環繞) the Pacific Basin.

The **magnitude** (強度) of the quake was 6.2. Houses were flattened and tens of thousands of people had to be **evacuated** (疏散). Electricity and communications were cut off in some parts of Yogyakrta, which bore the brunt of the quake.

Many **survivors** (幸存者) lost their homes and are exposed to heat during the day and chill and rain at night. Hospitals in the **disaster** (災難) zone still lack basic supplies to treat the of injured. The earthquake also left more than 40,000 children homeless.

## What to do

My

- 1. If you are indoors,drop down to the floor. Go under a strong desk or table.
- 2. If you are outside, get away from buildings and power lines.
- 3. If you are driving, stop if it is safe, but stay inside your car. Stay away from bridges and tunnels.
- 4. If you are in a mountainous area, or near slopes or cliffs, be careful of falling rocks and other objects.
- 5. If you are at the beach, move quickly to higher ground.
