

Fun with clay

Clay modelling is a popular pastime. However, making small-scale models is a fine art that needs steady hands, a pair of sharp eyes and a good memory. This art form recreates memories. It is like taking a snapshot photo in clay.

Miniature model expert Vivian Lee Ka-lin (李嘉蓮) said creating models is a good way to bring old memories back to life. "Things have disappeared over time, but we can

remember them forever with miniature art. Creating a **scaled down** 3D model of a memorable place is actually a good way to keep the memory alive."

A typical scale for miniatures is

1:24 or 1:12. **Precise** calculations are **essential** but having a good memory
and good mathematical skills are
only part of it. In an age of factoryproduced goods, being able to create
things by hand makes this art form
even more special.
