Tove Jansson had very artistic parents. Her father was a **sculptor** and her mother was an **illustrator**. She recalled that when she was young, she would sit by her mother and draw while her mother was working. Jansson published her first book when she was 13 years old!

Ugly' Moomins

There is an interesting story about how the Moomins were created. One day, Jansson argued with her brother about the philosopher Immanuel Kant. She probably disliked this famous thinker because she said she drew "the ugliest creature imaginable" on the toilet wall and wrote 'Kant' under it.

Later on, Jansson developed a Moomin comic strip for London's *Evening News* newspaper, and within two years, 120 newspapers around the world published it regularly, **reaching** 12 million readers.

A lifelong job

Was Jansson happy with the Moomin's **overwhelming** success? As a matter of fact, she was not. She said she was too busy with drawing the Moomins, so she had no time for painting and writing.
