History

IN 1948, Charles

P Lazarus founded a baby furniture store, but customers kept asking him for toys for babies and even older children. So he started selling them and changed the store's name to Children's Supermart, with 'Toys R Us' as the slogan. Eventually it became just Toys R Us.

Later, the brand **expanded** to other countries under Toys R Us **International**. Hong Kong got its first store in 1986, located in

Harbour City.



Mascot

BEFORE Toys R

Us was created, the baby furniture store already had a giraffe as its mascot. Its name was Dr G Raffe, which sounds like the word 'giraffe'. After Toys R Us formed, the giraffe's name was changed to Geoffrey the Giraffe. A plush toy version of Geoffrey can be bought in most Toys R Us stores.
