

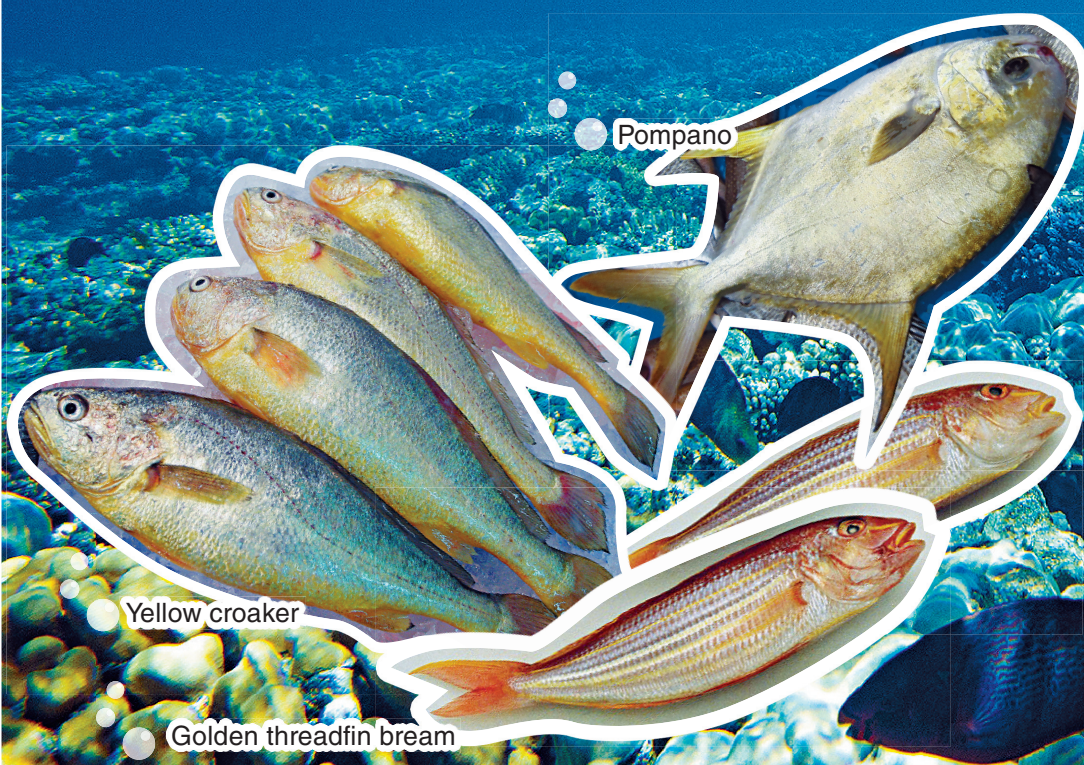

Save Hong Kong's fish

THERE used to be a lot of fish in the waters around Hong Kong, but their numbers have dropped because of over-fishing. That has made some fish species become endangered, meaning they might go

extinct. According to a survey by Hong Kong Baptist University's Organic Resource Centre (浸大有機資源中心), Hongkongers love to eat two species of fish that are endangered: the yellow croaker (*Larimichthys crocea*, 黃花魚) and the golden threadfin bream (*Nemipterus virgatus*, 紅衫魚). This

shows that locals do not have much awareness of what animals are under threat, especially marine ones. Another fish that many locals like to eat and whose number has decreased is the pompano (*Trachinotus blochii*, 黃魷鯰).
