HOW to Train Your Dragon: The Hidden World is set a year after the events of *How to Train Your Dragon 2*. Our **protagonist** Hiccup has become chief of his village, Berk, after his father Stoick, the old chief, died. Hiccup, his dragon Toothless and their friends the Dragon Riders fly around, saving dragons from dragon hunters. But Berk does not have enough space for all of them.

On one of their rescue **missions**, the Dragon Riders save a group of dragons from dragon sellers, except for one that can turn **invisible**. The hunters give this special dragon to Hiccup's enemy Grimmel the **Grisly**, who goes to Berk and ends up burning down Hiccup's house. The whole village then decides to move away to a safer spot.

The village moves closer to the

hidden dragon world that Stoick mentioned in the past. The Dragon Riders try to find it by flying around as scouts. But Toothless sees the special dragon that can turn invisible again and falls in love. Meanwhile, the relationship between Hiccup and his girlfriend Astrid is **advancing**.

So this third and final movie is about Hiccup and Toothless each finding love and **settling down**.
