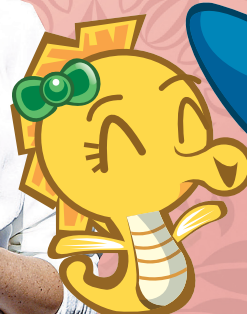
Welcome the new

THE UK is one of the few countries that still has a **monarchy**. But its queen has no real power; the actual head of government is the prime minister. The Queen is the longest **reigning** living monarch.



The royal family tree

LITTLE Archie is the first son and child of Prince Harry and Meghan. Harry is in turn the second son of the late Diana and Prince Charles of Wales. That title is always given to the **crown prince** in the UK. Charles is the first son and the eldest of the four children of the current queen, Elizabeth II, and her husband, Prince Philip. Elizabeth II was crowned queen back in 1953.



German background

QUEEN Elizabeth II and her family are from the House of Windsor. The family name was originally 'Saxe-Coburg and Gotha', but it was changed in 1917. The king back then, George V, thought the name was too German (德國的), as Germany was one of the UK's enemies during World War I. The Saxe-Coburg and Gotha name came from Prince Albert, the husband of Queen Victoria, who reigned during the 19th century.



Land of hope and glory

Although the Queen is the head of the UK, the prime minister and her government are the ones who make decisions, but they do it under the Queen's name. The character James Bond work for Her Majesty's **Secret Service**. Certain prisoners are "**detained** at Her Majesty's pleasure"! The UK is made up of four nations: England, Wales (威爾斯), Scotland (蘇格蘭) and Northern Ireland (北愛爾蘭). In Scotland you can eat **haggis**. It is made with sheep's heart, liver and lungs!
