Creating the holiday


IN parts of Europe and South America, 19 March was chosen because that day is St Joseph's Day – the day for Jesus's father on Earth. The third Sunday of June was first celebrated as Father's Day in the US, by a woman named Sonora Smart Dodd. She thought there should be a day for fathers, just like Mother's Day is for mums. Several US presidents tried to make it an **official** holiday, but none succeeded until US President Richard Nixon did in 1972.

Chinese beliefs

THE idea of Father's Day is known **worldwide**, but the concept that came to China was the American one. Thus, mainland China, Hong Kong and Macau all celebrate it on the third Sunday of June. Some in Taiwan, on the other hand, celebrate it on 8 August, because Father's Day can be called Papa's Day (爸爸節), and 'papa' sounds like 'ba-ba' – eight-eight (八八) – in Mandarin. Either way, Father's Day is still not an official holiday among the Chinese.
