THE movie studio decided to have the cast contain more Chinese characters. Yi is actually **voiced** by a half-Chinese American actress, Chloe Bennet.

Having an Asian cast in a Hollywood film is very important for Asian people and Asian actors. In the past, white people played Asian roles because Hollywood studios did not think Asian people were good enough to play leading parts in films. This is called discrimination.

But attitudes have changed recently as there are now more Hollywood films with Asian actors in main character roles.
